

Hazardous Materials



This course is designed for staff that may be required deal with any Hazardous Materials in the workplace, as part of their day-to-day work or as part of their role in the Emergency Response Team.

This course is aligned to the national standard for the Public Safety Training Package (PUA12). PUAFIR306A – Render hazardous materials incident safe. PUAFIR215 – Prevent Injury

Course Aims

- Enable participants to safely identify and handle hazardous materials
- Develop a basic understanding of hazard control procedures
- Define decontamination zones
- Outline best practice containment and recovery procedures for hazardous materials
- Introduce participants to safe decontamination procedures

At the completion of the training course participants will be armed with the skills, knowledge and confidence to work safely during a basic Hazardous Materials incident, while also developing sound teamwork skills. The course comprises an equal theoretical and practical component giving participants the opportunity to apply concepts in real situations.

- Hazardous Materials Incident management
- Protective Clothing
- Decontamination procedures
- Evacuation
- Containment methods
- Recovery
- Record keeping

- Introduction to HAZMAT - 1 day. (No prerequisites - *NOT NATIONAL UNIT*)
- HAZMAT qualification - 2 days. (Prerequisites – Recognised BA Qualification)
