

Height Safety

STAR International's Height Safety courses are intended for individuals who may be required to work at heights in their daily routine.

There are a range of programs covering, awareness, Working at Heights and an introduction to rescue techniques and equipment.

Courses cover the requirements set out in Australian Standards 1891, and are aligned to The Resource Industry Training Package unit RIIOHS204A – Work Safely at Heights.

Course Aims

The course is designed to provide;

- An outline of the legislation relating to work at heights.
- A guide to the options on how to comply.
- A background in how equipment can be utilised to achieve this.
- The details behind the equipment standards to ensure usage within the intended purpose.
- The criteria for issue, ID marking, inspection, record keeping, maintenance, storage and withdrawal from service.
